I, R. Venkatakrishnan (IBBI/IPA-001/IP-P00115/2017-18/10250), son of
K. Ramakrishnan, Hindu, aged about 60 years, Insolvency Resolution
Professional, having office at Rangas, 1/4, Fourth Main Road, R.A.Puram,
Chennai-600 028 do hereby solemnly affirm and sincerely state as
follows:-

1. The application for Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process was filed by Phoenix ARC Private Limited against M/s. St.John Freight Systems Limited (CIN: U74200TN1991PLC020999) under section 7 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code 2016 read with Rule 4 of Insolvency and Bankruptcy (Application to Adjudicating Authority) Rules 2016, was admitted by National Company Law Tribunal, Division Bench, Chennai vide order no. CP/759/(IB)/2018 dated 10.12.2018 wherein the undersigned was appointed as Interim Resolution Professional who was directed to take necessary actions in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code 2016. (herein after called '**Code**'),
2. The Public Announcement, in terms of Section 15 of the Code, was made in Form A as per Regulation 6 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (Insolvency Resolution Process for Corporate Persons) Regulations, 2016 (herein after called '**Regulations**') was made, intimating the commencement of Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process.
3. The Public Announcement was published on the website of Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India and on the website of the Corporate Debtor.
4. The Public Announcement made in accordance with the "Regulations" had stated the last date of submission of claim as 24th December, 2018.

5. Pursuant to the Public Announcement claims were received from various creditors. After verification of claims, the report constituting the Committee of Creditors had been filed with the Adjudicating Authority on 02nd January 2019. Based on the claims received after 02nd January 2019, Revision No.1 to the Report constituting the Committee of Creditors had been filed with the Adjudicating Authority on 21st January 2019. Further to the claims received after 21st January, 2019, Revision no.2 to the Report constituting the Committee of Creditors had been filed with the Adjudicating Authority on 15th April 2019. Revision no.3 to the report was filed on 06th May 2019. Revision no.4 to the report was filed on 13th August 2019. The report certifying the Constitution of Creditors as per Revision No.4 consisted of the following:

Note-1: Claim of State Bank of India consists of Loan of Rs.33,15,22,769 crores sanctioned to the Corporate Debtor and a loan of Rs. 15,93,93,415 obtained by its wholly owned subsidiary in respect of which a Corporate Guarantee has been extended by the Corporate Debtor.

The Corporate Guarantee was invoked by State Bank of India as on 10.12.2018, based on the information provided.

Note-2: Claim amount of Indian Overseas Bank is pursuant to credit facility of USD 5.75 Million extended to the Corporate Debtor's wholly owned subsidiary by Indian Overseas Bank, Colombo Branch. The Corporate Debtor has issued a Corporate Guarantee to Indian Overseas Bank for the Stand-By Letter of Credit (SBLC). The Corporate Guarantee was invoked prior to Insolvency Commencement Date (ICD).

Indian Overseas Bank has submitted a claim of USD 52,77,599.77. The claims in USD have been converted to INR as per the foreign exchange rate provided by RBI as on 10.12.2018 i.e.(ICD) in terms of Regulation 15. As on 10.12.2018 1 USD = INR 71.3257.

Note-3: Claim amount of Axis Bank consists of Rs. 11,09,43,636 pertaining to the Loan amount sanctioned to M/s. St.John Trade and Tour Proprietor Mr. T.Johnson and credit facility of USD 2 Million extended to the Corporate Debtor's wholly owned subsidiary by Axis Bank – Singapore Branch.

In respect of the loan sanctioned to M/s. St.John Trade and Tour the Corporate Debtor has extended a Corporate Guarantee and the same was invoked by Axis Bank prior to Insolvency Commencement Date.

In respect of the credit facility to the Corporate Debtor's subsidiary, the bank has extended a Stand-By Letter of Credit (SBLC) based on the Corporate Guarantee of the Corporate Debtor. The SBLC has not been invoked by Axis Bank Limited as on 10.12.2018. The claims in USD have been converted to INR as per the foreign exchange rate provided by RBI as on 10.12.2018 i.e. (ICD) in terms of Regulation 15. As on 10.12.2018 one USD = INR 71.3257.

Applying the principles enunciated by the Honourable National Company Law Appellate Tribunal, New Delhi in the case of "**Andhra Bank Vs. M/s. F.M.Hammerle Textile Limited dated 13.07.2018, Company Appeal (AT) (Insolvency) No. 61 of 2018**" where it was held that it is not necessary that all the claims as are submitted by the Creditor should be a claim matured on the date of initiation of Resolution Process/admission, even in respect of debt, which is due in future on its maturity, the 'Financial Creditor' or 'Operational Creditor' or 'Secured Creditor' or 'Unsecured Creditor' can file such claim. The definition of 'Claim' as defined under Section 3(6) is to be read along with Section 13 read with Section 15 of the 'I&B Code'.

In light of the above judgment, the claim submitted, in respect of which Creditor has not invoked the Corporate Guarantee or SBLC as on the ICD is accepted and will be revised, if required.

Note-4: SMAS Auto Leasing India Private Limited has submitted the claim in Form-C averring as Financial Creditor and has submitted supporting documents. The claim submitted is pursuant to the Master Lease Agreement entered into by the Corporate Debtor and SMAS Auto Leasing India Private Limited stating to be a Financial Lease.

Section 5(8) of Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 defines Financial Debt as debt along with interest which is disbursed against the consideration for the time value of money which inter alia includes in sub-clause (d) - the amount of any liability in respect of any lease or hire purchase contract which is deemed as a finance or capital lease under the Indian Accounting Standards or such other accounting standards as may be prescribed.

On reviewing the various clauses of the Master Lease-Agreement it was observed in Clause 14, Use and Maintenance of the Vehicle, inter alia provides that The Lessee will not claim any right, title or interest in the vehicle and/or parts, components thereof.

In terms of Indian Accounting Standard – 17 A lease will be classified as a finance lease if it transfers substantially all the risks and rewards incidental to ownership.

It is evident from the Master Lease Agreement entered into by SMAS Auto Leasing India Private Limited that the claim cannot be treated as Financial Lease but has to be treated as an Operational Lease. The same will be treated as Operational Creditor under the Code.

Note-5: Claim submitted by G.V.R.S.Manian is for Rs.66,50,000 excluding interest. On reviewing the documents submitted, it is observed that DPN was available only for Rs. 42,50,000 @ 8% p.a. The documents do not evidence stamping in accordance with Section 35 of the Indian Stamp Act 1935. Accordingly, the claim will be classified under other creditors in terms of Regulations 9A.

Note-6: Claim submitted by P.K.Nandha Kumar is for Rs.80,00,000. On perusal of the claim form submitted, it is noted that there are no

documents establishing that amount advanced is a financial debt as per Section 5(8) of the Code and interest details except the letter from the Corporate Debtor during the year 2017 confirming the amount payable to P.K.Nandha Kumar. A case has been filed under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

In view of the above, the claim cannot be classified as Financial Debt, since the amount was not advanced against the consideration for the time value of money, based on the details provided. It will be classified as other creditor as per Regulation 9A.

Note-7: Claim pertaining to the creditors listed from S.No.25 to 54 was submitted in a spreadsheet by Mr. Vinod Chhabria vide electronic mail dated 24.12.2018 in respect of 30 creditors. The claims were not submitted in form prescribed in Regulation 8. Communications have been sent informing to submit the claims in the prescribed form. No claims have been submitted till the date of constitution the Committee of Creditors.

Note-8: Initially IDBI Bank Limited claim was as on 19.12.2018 whereas the ICD date is 10.12.2018. During 10.12.2018 to 19.12.2018 IDBI has closed the Fixed Deposit of Rs.1,05,35,724 maintained by the Corporate Debtor after declaration of Moratorium under Section 13. Thereafter, IDBI Bank Limited reversed the adjustment of Fixed Deposit.

Note-9: The claim submitted by Mr. A R Raghunadhan and Mrs.R Jeyasri were reviewed with the available documents. The documents do not evidence stamping in accordance with Section 35 of the Indian Stamp Act

1935. Accordingly, the claim will be classified under other creditors in terms of Regulations 9A.

Note-10: Claim submitted by Acme Commodities P Ltd is for Rs.35,00,000. On perusal of the claim form submitted, it is noted that there are no documents establishing that amount advanced is a financial debt as per Section 5(8) of the Code and interest details.

In view of the above, the claim cannot be classified as Financial Debt, since the amount was not advanced against the consideration for the time value of money, based on the details provided. It will be classified as other creditor as per Regulation 9A.

Note-11: Claim amount of SREI Infrastructure Finance Limited pertaining to the Loan Amount sanctioned to M/s. Raffles Supply Chain Solution Private Limited.

In respect of the loan sanctioned to M/s. M/s. Raffles Supply Chain Solution Private Limited the Corporate Debtor has extended a Corporate Guarantee and the same was not invoked by SREI Infrastructure Finance Limited prior to Insolvency Commencement Date.

Applying the principles stated in Note-3 the claim submitted in respect of which Creditor has not invoked the Corporate Guarantee as on the ICD, is accepted and will be revised, if required.

Note-12: A claim with proof in FORM C was received from Mesica Aps claiming an amount of USD.566,052.28 (Rs.4,03,74,075) as on ICD, receivable from the Corporate Debtor. Details for the purposes of

verification of claim have been sought for and claim will be determined accordingly.
